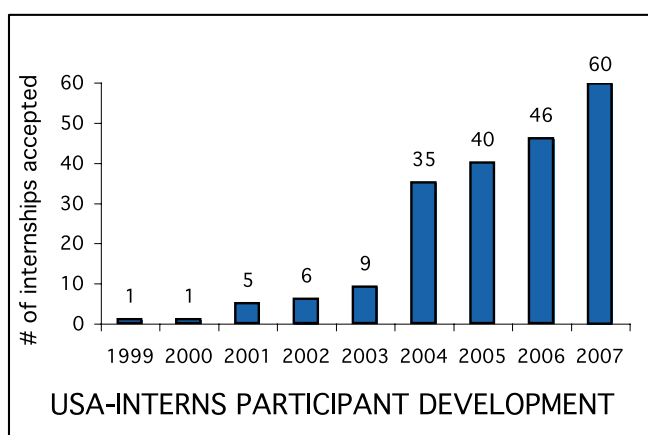

Partnerships with all institutes of higher education in Hessen due to our cooperation with the Hessen Ministry of Education, Research and the Arts.

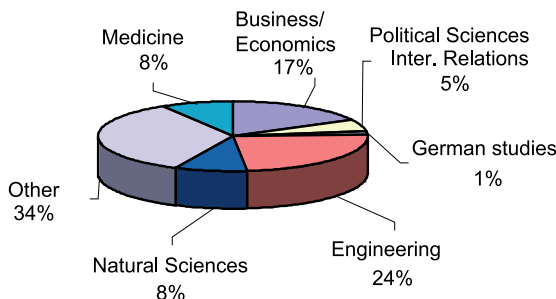

It was founded by the Steuben-Schurz-Gesellschaft e.V. in 1999 and has been co-financed by the U.S. Consulate General Frankfurt from 2003 through 2007. The Hessen Ministry of Higher Education, Research and the Arts is a partner of our program.

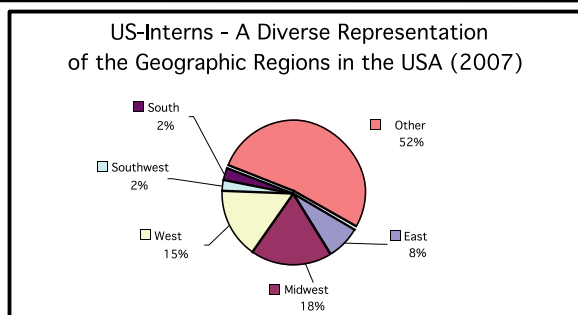
